LE ROMAIN resumes from a 22w spell for the Kris Lees establishment. The Hard Spun 4yo gelding won first-up on resuming back in Jan and with anticapted WFA advancement, he could salute again. Christian Reith gains the mount and he's been successful on the gelding back in March @ this track





MOUNT NEBO has been up since June and we don't anticipate any improvement for today's run. Watch prices closer to start time. Jason Collett onboard for the Alan Denham Wyong stable.



MESSENE resumes from a 3mth spell for the Hawkes stable. The Lonhro 8yo can run well fresh and on past performances we simply cannot rule him out. Tommy Berry gains the mount.



DECISION TIME seems to be on a bit of an improvement cycle even though the Conners trained 9yo has been up for ages.

REBEL DANE is going to be nicely improved by his first-up 2nd to Tycoon Tara in the Missile Stakes a fortnight back. The mares look to have her measure and the early odds are too low for us anyway.



SIGNOFF resumes from a 24w spell for the Darren Weir stable. The 7yo was a big winner of the Lord Reims Stks @ 2600m @ this track in March. May find the 1400m a bit too short but with the anticipated Heavy8 conditions, this race may turn out to be more like a 1600m contest. Harry Coffey rides Weir horses very well RUNWAY STAR did well enough last outing which followed a 10w let-up. Can and should be nicely improved by the run. Page a hold 2nd in Heavy 2 as a younger berse so we cannot discount him. The distance





ULMANN is another Darren Weir runner and he's been installed the early fav. by other analysts. His last three runs have been very solid without showing us any significant improvement in ratings? If he doesn't improve today on a strange track, then he's a bad value conveyance in our book. John Allen to ride.



ROCKET COMMANDER – cannot rule out. Looks to be nicely above our required price



RIZIZ – is on the improve and we cannot rule him out. Early odds far too low for us.

In this event No.1 Signoff was value, No.13 Rocket Commander value & No.8 Gamblin' Guru was value. Then go to the Rec. Bet (Recommended Bet) column and follow this advice for your individual First4's

To get the lowest % possible on TAB's of 1% we had to spend \$9 which is over double the Rec. Bet so we moved to the next ratio TREBLE the Rec.Bet for our outsider No.4 Gamblin Guru. Some TAB's allow factions of a % but ALL insist it must be at least 1% We do the same with all the other VALUE chances (TREBLE their Rec. Bet) to achieve close to a Betting To Chances professional approach. Profit is your objective whether you're a big punter or a small punter. It's return on your investment that matters.

First4's are not easy but we think if you limit them to the large fields (13 minimum) & go where the largest pools are, then you can profit i.e. PROVIDING you have a set of INDIVIDUALLY sourced prices that attempt to highlight the TRUE value i.e. a price you should achieve on each horse in the race. We've been doing this for over 20 years so you can be confident that we've done our homework.

SHIRAZ comes into the event following a 20w spell for the Tony McEvoy Flemington stable. This is his first test on the turning Moonee Valley circuit & we've taken this into account in his pricing. However, he's won 4 from 6 first-up and we have to assume this track will not be a major concern. Luke Currie onboard today



HEATHERLY is another resuming from a spell. The Ellerton / Zahra trained 4yo has been off the scene for 6 months but his record fresh is solid. Damian Lane has the mount for his return.



ATMOSPHERICAL did very well first-up when just 1.8 lens 3rd behind Wild Rain @ 1100m @ Caulfield. If the Robert Smerdon trained 6yo can improve on this, then we simply cannot rule him out. Has been given a 5w freshening to today's contest. This has been a deliberate tactic by the stable to keep him fresh.



VIDDORA won at Morphettville over the 1050m trip run in Soft6 conditions. The Lloyd Kennewell trained 4yo should improve on that rating 2nd up but will it be enough to win this? Early odds are close to ours so if this drifts, then we certainly will jump onboard. Joe Bowditch is over from SA to ride replacing M. Neilson.



GENERAL TRUCE carried 58.5k last start and finished just 2.45 lens 5th behind Wild Rain. His ratings 2 runs prior when he beat Bullpit over this trip @ Flemington, clearly qualifys him for this contest. Has won twice on this track and over this trip. Andrew Mallyon rides him well.
