Gauging Weight For Age improvement on his last preparation under a European model puts him well above these on expected ratings. First-up today & Damien Oliver engaged. Should win
	MASTER ZEPHYR resumed with a solid 3.2 lens 3 rd to Royal Rapture. Up 100m helps 2 nd up but his best ratings should be over longer later on in the Spring. C. Williams gains the mount for the Weir establishment. Another European import that technically is still a 4yo & looks to be in for a good Spring.
	MIHANY has the best potential to stop the Weir juggernaut. Was given a let-up by the Hayes/Dabernig camp and sent to contest a lowly Bm82 but was unable to get past the enigmatic Outlandish Lad @ 1300m. Will be fitter for the hit-out. A negative is Regan Bayliss only claims ½k as he's been riding at 53.5k of late.

	SHEIDEL is another resuming from a spell. The Hayes/Dabernig trained Roman Emperor 5yo mare deos race very well first-up having won 2 from 3 and placed 2 nd in the other. Odds need to improve for us.

	WHO SHOT THEBARMAN handles most track conditions and will be much fitter 2 nd up. The 1600m could feel more like an 1800m event & Blake Shinn has the ride for the Waller establishment. Love the early odds.
	PRIZED ICON has won 2 from 3 in Soft5 & 6. As a baby he ran a credible 1.6 lens 3 rd in Heavy8 at his first attempt. Ready to improve 2 nd up but we cannot come into the More Than Reacyd 3yo colt @ the suggested early odds.
	PREFERMENT is another that resumes. This Zabeel 5yo could run a bold race fresh and has been given 3 barrier trials in preparation for his return. The 1600m maybe the main impediment but we think he'll handle the track condition well enough. Lousy odds early.

	KEEN ARRAY resumes from a 23w spell for the Hayes/Dabernig yard. Did little first-up in the Oakleigh Plate back in February. However, we think the whole last campaign could be wiped as a guide for this preparation. Was smart at the preparation prior to this so we think the Bel Esprit gelding could surprise at big odds today.
	ROUGH JUSTICE should be close to his peek today @ 3 rd run back from a spell. At his 2 nd run back he was blocked for a run near the 400m but still managed to finish just 2 lens from Just Magical @ this trip & track.
	HANDSOME TYCOON has won his past 6 however they have been up in the sand tracks of the Northern Territory. Did win most of the cash in their top sprints so has a bit going for him. Has had a run at this track & finished a credible 3 rd this time last year.
	LE BONSIIR could be worthy of a smaller bet. Due to show us something and the odds are equal to ours in early markets. Was just 2.2 lens from Just Magical in a Bm90 @ this track and trip last start when carrying 58k with a 3k claimer onboard.
